Year 4	<p>Accurately follow and give instructions. Confidently communicate my ideas and listen to others. Plan and apply strategies to solve problems. Reflect on when and why I was successful at solving challenges. Work collaboratively and effectively with a partner and a small group. Identify key symbols on a map and use a key to help navigate around a grid.</p>

Year 5	<p>Use critical thinking skills to approach a task. Reflect on when I was successful at solving challenges and alter my methods in order to improve. Inclusive of others and can share job roles. Work effectively with a partner and a small group, sharing ideas and agreeing on a team strategy. Navigate around a course using a map. Orientate a map confidently.</p>
